Dawson College is inviting applications for the position of Certified Athletic Therapist. Dawson College has an enrollment of 7500 students and is a member of the Réseau du Sport Étudiant du Québec (RSEQ) and the Canadian Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA).

Reporting to the Manager of Student Services & Athletics, the incumbent has to provide for the well-being of student athletes for all 15 teams, allowing them to achieve their maximum potential. They will be in charge of creating a learning environment for the Concordia University internship students in the Athletic Therapy program in a field and clinical setting. For a fee, the therapist will also be able to rent clinic space and treat general public both from within the college and the outside public throughout the year.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Clinical injury assessment and treatment for Dawson athlete's and general public
- Efficient charting skills and ability to correct student's charts
- Strong on-field injury management
- Being present at all required home games, tournaments and practices
- Encourage and teach students in their internship
- Monitor students progress and identify potential problems for students, which may be an obstacle to successful completion of their training
- Complete evaluations of internship students
- Communicate with the Athletics Department
- Participate actively in all activities required by the Athletics Department

Qualifications:

- Graduated from a CATA accredited institution and be a Certified Athletic Therapist
- In good standing with your provincial association as well as CATA
- Have valid professional liability insurance
- Minimum of 1 years of experience in athletic therapy
- Have a valid Sports First Responder certification or equivalent
- Strong communicational and organizational skills;
- Capacity to interact positively with college student athletes;
- Ability to work harmoniously in a team setting;
- Strong verbal communication skills in English and French.
